Description:

Matters of Community (MOC), a non-profit social services agency in Fremont, CA was experiencing an ever increasing drain on office productivity due to incoming Spam that needed to be deleted at each terminal on a daily basis. MOC was also concerned about implementing secure communications with other related agency offices of various organizations to protect the privacy of its clients and prevent the inadvertent corrupting of its computer files.

Solution:

BroadScan was introduced as an all-in-one solution approach to filter Spam, Viruses and Spyware from incoming and outgoing email and other files being within and without the agency.

1. SCN200 gateway was deployed at the central office where agency account servers were located.
2. SCN200 gateways are expected to be deployed at future outlying branch offices, each typically supporting 6 to 10 terminals for MOC staff and volunteers.

An SCN200 gateway was installed at the MOC office to protect Web servers and computer terminals.
